



Improving care for people with learning disabilities is one of NHS England's top priorities for 2015-16.

This includes:

- Children or young people with a learning disability and/or autism who display or are at risk of developing, risky behaviours which may put themselves or others at risk and which could lead to contact with the criminal justice system
- Children or young people with a learning disability and/ or autism, often with lower level support needs and who may not traditionally be known to health and social care services, who may be from disadvantaged backgrounds

The workstream aims to support and promote early intervention and detection of those who may require additional support and multi agency planning, as well as develop support pathways close to home, and that avoid hospitalisation.

Transforming Care Partnerships across the country will be establishing processes and practice to get help and support to where it is needed, rapidly and effectively. A local "At Risk of Admission" register will be developed, and for those at risk a Community Care and Treatment Review will be undertaken.
