Build bullying audit into individual pupil reviews and Structured Conversations

This is a simple tool, needing very little in terms of resource or training, nevertheless having a significant impact on parent and pupil perceptions about a school's commitment to taking bullying behaviour seriously. SEND support plans can be edited so that learners and parent/carers have a clear and explicit route to take if bullying occurs.

For example bullying audits can be built into:

- Parents evenings
- Individual Educational Plans / other SEND review plans
- Annual reviews of Statements

Such an approach must not be perceived as some of sort "admission" that bullying is occurring. It must be perceived by all parties as a proactive, preventative strategy... "if bullying occurs, we are committed to dealing with it quickly and effectively".
